14.	Eligibility of Tenderers	This invitation for Tenders is open to all eligible Tenderers as mentioned below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Contractor's firms who have minimum 05 (five) years of general experience in construction works. Successful completion of construction of any RCC framed structure building in a package contract with Civil, Sanitary &amp; Electrical works during the last 05 (five) years preceding tender submission date in any govt. /semi govt./ autonomous body in a single contract of value not less than Tk. 1.00 (one) crore. The experience certificate for successful completion of a building work shall have to be issued by the officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer/Project Manager of concerned Department/Organization Department/ Organization.</li> <li>ii. Liquid asset or cash flow: Tk. 30,00,000.00 (Thirty lacs). Only</li> <li>iii. Average Annual Turnover: Tk. 70,00,000.00 (Seventy lacs ) Only</li> <li>iv. Tender Capacity : Must satisfy by the Tenderer as per his/her quoted Tender Price</li> <li>v. Tenderer must have upto date Income tax clearance certificate from the concerned Department.</li> <li>vi. Tenderer must have valid VAT Registration certificate from the concerned Department.</li> <li>vii. Tenderer must have upto date Trade License.</li> <li>viii. 15.	Liquidity Damage	The liquidated damages for the whole of the Works are 0.5% (zero point five percent) of the final Contract Price per day. The maximum amount of liquidated damages for the whole of the Works is 10% (ten percent) of the final Contract Price.
16.	Defect Liability	The Defects Liability Period is 365 (Three hundred sixty five ) days
17.	Performance Guarantee	The Performance guarantee shall of an amount equal to 10% of the Contract Price stated in the Letter of acceptance & shall be valid until a date 60 days from the date of expiry of Defect Liability Period.
18.	Retention Money	The proportion of payments retained is Ten (10) percent from each interim payment certificate.

The Tenderers Eligibility document (Technical Tender) and Priced Tender document shall be submitted in two separate Envelopes, marked ENVELOPE-1 and ENVELOPE-2 respectively and these two envelopes shall be sealed in an outer Envelope. The "Technical Tender" shall be evaluated first in order to determine the eligibility of the Tenderers to be included in the competition. <b>P.O. or D.D. of Tk. 3,00,000/- (Taka Three lacs) should be submitted in the envelope containing Technical Tender.</b> The "Price Tender document" of the Tenderers, who will be found eligible to compete in the priced Tender, shall ONLY be opened.</li> <li>ii) The Agency/procuring entity reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the Tender without assigning any reasons whatsoever.</li> <li>iii) Two sets of Tender shall be submitted; one in original and one in copy.
